2017 AFA REDS

2013 CHATEAU YALDARA RESERVE GRENACHE SHIRAZ MATARO (RRP \$45.00) *Gold Medals*

Lots of fruit purity here. There's blue and confectionary from the Grenache, along with brooding darkness from the Mataro. Cue Shiraz with its chocolate and firm but fine tannins. Finishing with spice, this is complex and delicious.

2011 GLENLOFTY SINGLE VINEYARD CABERNET SAUVIGNON (RRP \$26.00) *93pts James Halliday, 2 Gold Medals*

A stunning Cabernet that's been given the full French oak treatment. Stacks of dark fruit and violets framed by fine, almost silky tannins. This opens up in the glass over an hour or more. Superb now and should be magnificent in 10 years..

2015 CURTIS FAMILY VINEYARDS CAVALIERE CABERNET SAUVIGNON (RRP \$70.00)

4.5 Stars and Top in Category Winestate, 94pts James Halliday

A superb first release Cabernet under the Curtis Cavaliere label and as good as you'd expect if you've had the Shiraz previously. Lots going on here, with chocolate, spice, cedary oak and lots of fine tannins. Decant for an hour or so if you want to try it now or stick it in the broom closet for up to 10 years.

2013 CHATEAU YALDARA RESERVE SHIRAZ (RRP \$45.00)

Gold Medal, 92pts James Halliday, 91pts The Wine Front Magazine

Barossa Shiraz on an epic scale here, 16% alcohol and matured in a combo of French and American oak. It carries the alcohol and oak well, offering plum, chocolate and coffee and relatively fine tannins given its weight elsewhere. Big, generous and in need of a steak or something beefy.

2016 RICHARD HAMILTON CENTURION SHIRAZ (RRP \$80.00)

This is a brilliantly concentrated wine, full of layers of flavour, texture and concentration. Has a lushness reminiscent of the exceptional 2012 release of this wine which scored 97 points from James Halliday. Produced from a heritage plot of 124 year old McLaren Vale vines. Will cellar 20 years plus.

2015 CURTIS FAMILY VINEYARDS LIMITED SERIES MCLAREN VALE SHIRAZ (RRP \$100.00) *94pts James Halliday*

Rippingly good, fine boned yet full bodied McLaren Vale Shiraz. We reckon this one will improve with cellaring for 20 years, such is its structure and power of fruit. Lots of black and blue fruits here, along with aristocratic spindles of cedary oak.

2017 AFA WHITES

2017 BIRD IN HAND SAUVIGNON BLANC (RRP \$25.00)

A classic mix of gooseberry along with passionfruit on the nose. Same again Same on the palate which is passionfruity, layered with greenery, stonefruits and a little lemon curd.

2015 JEANNERET BIG FINE GIRL RIESLING (RRP \$22.00) *Silver Medal*

Bigger than your usual Clare Valley Riesling, this 2015 vintage is bright and floral on the nose and the palate shows citrus flavours of lemon and lime joined together with orange blossoms. It is powerfully packed with fruit, finishing with refreshing acid and a hint of Bickfords Brown Lime.

2016 LECONFIELD COONAWARRA OLD VINES RIESLING (RRP \$26.00) *Gold Medal, 95pts James Halliday*

A great Riesling offering with fresh Tahitian limes, fresh citrus zest and minerality. The palate is zingy and zippy but also has bags of flavour, again in the lime/citrus spectrum along with a touch of lavender, honey and blossoms.

2013 SIDEWOOD MAPPINGA 'FUME' SAUVIGNON BLANC (RRP \$35.00) *4 Gold Medal, 93pts James Halliday*

A delicate and quite fragrant wine offering stone fruits of nectarine and peach along with a serve of crunchy pear. Structure and fruity crunch is good here, you can probably drink over the next 3 or 4 years as the wine gains toasty complexity.

2016 ZONTE'S FOOTSTEP DUSK TIL DAWN CHARDONNAY (RRP \$35.00) *2 Gold Medal*

Sleek, modern and beautifully elegant, this is an excellent Chardonnay offering struck match smokiness, cedary French oak and stacks of stone fruit. Lively but integrated acidity gives both lift and length to the fruit and creaminess of the mouthfeel.

2013 STONIER RESERVE CHARDONNAY (RRP \$53.00) *96pts James Halliday*

World class Chardonnay from the Mornington Peninsula from estate grown vines which are at least 30 years of age. This has just brilliant fruit, sucking up the 50% new oak used with ease. This offers great texture, honeydew melon, stonefruits, creaminess, a little struck match and a fine wisp of cedary oak tannins on the finish. Awesome!
